DECISION

The Ministry of Health as the administrative body with jurisdiction to decide on granting, extending, not granting or removing accreditation pursuant to the provisions of Section 49 (8) of Act No. 96/2004 Coll., on terms and conditions of obtaining and recognition of qualification for performance of non-medical health professions and for conducting of activities related to provision of health care and on amendments to certain acts (Act on Non-Medical Health Professions), as amended and supplemented (hereinafter referred to only as Act No. 96/2004 Coll.), after assessing the application of the below-specified applicant, as filed on 26 February 2016, decided pursuant to the provisions of Section 49 (2) of Act No. 96/2004 Coll. and pursuant to the provisions of Section 49 (3) of Act No. 96/2004 Coll. and pursuant to the provisions of Section 49 (3) of Act No. 96/2004 Coll. and supplemented (hereinafter referred to only as the Administrative Code), as follows:

Justification

On 26 February 2016, the applicant, SVR – společnost pro vývojovou rehabilitaci o.p.s., with its registered seat at the address Dvořákova 468, 363 01 Ostrov, filed its application for granting of accreditation for conducting an educational program – certified course *Therapy using global locomotion patterns of ontogenetic development – Vojta's therapy 2nd generation "VM2G"*.

The application of the party to the proceedings was discussed at the session of the accreditation committee organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 47 (1) of Act No. 96/2004 Coll., as the advisory body of the minister of health authorized to evaluate such applications. At such meeting, which took place on 1 February 2017, the accreditation committee unanimously recommended that the party to the proceedings supplement its application. By virtue of the Call to remedy deficiencies of an application dated 1 March 2017, file number MZDR 14204/2016-20/ONP, the applicant was called upon by the administrative body to supplement documents proving its education, translated into the official language, i.e., the Czech language (an officially certified translation of such documents was requested). The applicant was also called upon to submit the Certificate of Passing the Certified Course of Vojta's Therapy or the Certificate of an Educational Therapist issued by the international company (Internationale Vojta Gesellschaft e. V.). The applicant, SVR – společnost pro vývojovou rehabilitaci o.p.s., with its registered seat at the address Dvořákova 468, 363 01 Ostrov, subsequently remedied the deficiencies by its letter dated 21 March 2017, whereby it complied with the condition set forth by Section 46 (3) of Act No. 96/2004 Coll., i.e., submitted the documents proving its professional competence or, as the case may be, qualification, as corresponding to the focus of the educational program. After such amending, the applicant complied with the conditions for granting of accreditation pursuant to the provisions of Section 46 of Act No. 96/2004 Coll.

The above-specified entity shall be liable for observing the level and content of education in the certified course.

Based on the above-specified facts, the ministry has decided to grant accreditation to implementation of the education program – certified course *Therapy using global locomotion patterns of ontogenetic development* – *Vojta's method (system)* 2^{nd} *generation "VM2G"*, with the educational program designed for physiotherapists.

Information

An appeal may be filed against this decision pursuant to the provisions of Section 152 (1) of the Administrative Code to the Ministry of Health through the Department of Nursery and Non-Medical Professions within 15 days following its notification. The minister of health shall decide on such appeal. The deadline for filing of the appeal shall commence on the day following the date on which this decision was notified.
